MOTOR VEHICLE CLAUSES

INTEREST: Motor Vehicles

BASIS OF VALUATION: The current market value at destination plus freight and other charges or as may be declared and agreed prior to shipment

PERIOD OF INSURANCE: The insurance attaches from time of commencement of loading the insured vehicle on board the carrying vessel or conveyance at the port of shipment until completion of the unloading of the vehicle at the port of discharge. If no other insurance is in force the policy is extended to cover the vehicle whilst on quay or in warehouse before or after shipment for a period not exceeding 72 hours.

Containerised vehicles - from container base to container base.
Extension of insurance to cover further transit or storage held covered at additional premium to be arranged.

CONDITIONS: Against all risks of physical loss or damage to the insured vehicle as per Institute Cargo Clauses (A) as far as applicable.
But subject to the following:-

- A) The vehicle must be insured for its full value at destination otherwise the full amount of the claim will not be recoverable.
- B) In the event of a claim for loss of or damage to any part or parts, the company shall not be liable for more than the cost of repairing or replacing such lost or damaged parts.
- C) A pre-shipment condition report where "All Risk" cover is required on used or second-hand vehicles.
- D) The Insurance EXCLUDES liability in respect of:-

1) The first £250 agreed of any claim

- 2) Loss of or damage to the insured vehicle whilst being driven under its own power except whilst being driven on/off the vessel/container.
- 3) Excluding Third Party Liability absolutely
- 4) Mechanical or electrical break-down, failure or breakages.
- 5) Frost Damage
- 6) The risks of theft and/or pilferage of radios and/or cassette tape recorders and decks and/or speakers and/or similar interests unless stolen with the vehicle.
- 7) Scratching, chipping, denting, bruising, rust, oxidation, discoloration and subsequent re-painting on used or second-hand vehicles where there is no pre-shipment report.
- 8) Rust, oxidation and discoloration on unpacked and unprotected vehicles shipped on deck.
